Dear Exhibitor

The Society for Radiological Protection will be holding its 7th International Symposium from 12th to 17th June 2005 in the capital of Wales, Cardiff – which will be celebrating its centenary year. This is a major international event for the radiological protection community which is held at approximately four year intervals. The Symposium attracts a substantial number of delegates from the UK, Europe and elsewhere representing interests from all professional areas.

A commercial Exhibition will be held alongside the Symposium from Sunday 12th to Wednesday 15th, building on previous successful symposia. To obtain your preferred exhibition site, book early to avoid disappointment. A provisional layout plan is attached. Set-up will take place on Sunday afternoon and the exhibition will close at 12 noon on the Wednesday. All Tea/Coffee and Lunch sessions will be held in the Exhibition Hall, as well as an Exhibitors reception (Sunday evening) giving ample time for delegates to view your stands.

Each exhibition stand will consist of a 3m x 2m shell scheme standing on carpet, with lighting, an electrical outlet and a fascia board showing your Company name at just £800 (+VAT) for SRP Affiliates and £1200 (+VAT) for non-Affiliates for the 3 days. The Exhibition space will be allocated on a first come, first served basis, so reserve your place by booking early. Full instructions on how to book are enclosed with this invitation.

There will also be the opportunity for commercial sponsorship (including delegate bags, pens and stationery) and advertising both in the proceedings (which will be available during the symposium) and inserts in the delegate bags. Please contact us for further details of these opportunities.
